In reverent observance of Holy Week, we will refrain from making announcements before the liturgies on **Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday**.

These sacred days invite us into the heart of the Paschal Mystery – a time of profound prayer, reflection, and silence. By minimizing spoken interruptions, we allow the faithful to enter more deeply into the solemnity and mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Let this silence serve as a gesture of reverence, drawing our hearts toward the sacred mysteries we are about to celebrate this Holy Week.

A Reminder: When Not Receiving the Body and Blood of Christ

During the Communion procession at Mass, all are welcome to come forward. If you are not receiving Holy Communion, you are still invited to join the procession as an act of reverence for the Real Presence of Jesus Christ—*truly present in the consecrated bread and wine, Christ's Body and Precious Blood*.

- To indicate that you will not be receiving, please cross your arms over your chest or place your fingers over your lips as you approach the priest or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC). They will offer a brief prayer by saying: *The peace of Christ*, accompanied by a reverent bow of the head. You may then return to your pew for silent prayer and reflection.
- Please note that an individual blessing during Communion is not necessary, as the entire congregation receives the priest's blessing at the conclusion of Mass.

Even in the act of refraining from receiving the Eucharist, we are reminded of the sacred mystery of Christ's presence among us. May this moment deepen our longing for Him, renew our devotion, and draw us ever closer to the heart of our Eucharistic Lord.

On March 22nd, 50 Whatcom Catholic parishioners gathered together to clean up the grounds of St. Joachim. We were blessed by a sunny day and delicious donuts brought by a parishioner. This cleanup is in conjunction with St. Joachim being chosen as a pilgrimage site. The Jubilee pilgrim year occurs once every 25 years across the world. The pilgrimage helps to shine a light on the rich faith history of St. Joachim, which is located on the Lummi reservation. As we work and engage with Partners in the Gospel, we cannot truly plan for our future without thinking about our past.

This clean-up also helped to highlight the important renovation work that needs to be done to preserve this church for another 164 years. If you haven't read Fr. Moore's letter, please visit his website where he details the significant renovation work we need to accomplish.

With our cleanup crew we were able to power wash sidewalks and part of the parking lot, weed all flower beds, pick up stick and other debris, clean gutters, and remove a thicket of blackberries. All Whatcom County Churches were represented along with students from Assumption Catholic School. We are so blessed by our volunteers!

Phase 1 fundraising Goal Met

We are so thankful for the 30 donors who stepped up to raise 12,878.60. This money will be used to fulfill the following projects:

- A plaque to memorialize Chief Kiwna to be placed at the Centenary shrine. Chief Kiwna donated the land that the church currently sits on.
- A plaque to provide information about the "Arrival" Totem.
- A new church sign that provides updated information, and that can easily be updated for the needs of the community.
- New lights for the sanctuary

We are thankful for a program from PSE, which will allow us to update all the lightbulbs in the Church for free. This upgrade will replace the current fluorescent lights to energy-efficient LED lights. A small fee might be associated with the replacement dependent if they can reach the lights without a ladder. Any money not spent in phase 1, will be put towards phase 2 projects.

We currently need to fundraise 33,121.4 until we hit our Phase 2 restoration goal.
